Art Installation in Main Foyer



Six donors of \$2 million and up will each have their names included on the lower right portion of the art piece that was commissioned in honor of our largest donors. The sketch of the art piece shown was created by Native youth artist Phil Gray. It will be mounted on the wall of the main foyer of the NYC. It will be approximately 8 feet tall by 5 feet wide. The placements of names will from top to bottom according to the size of the donation (largest to smallest). Donors will receive a framed photo with the youth artist and be given agreed upon rights to use the artwork in their promotional materials in relation to the Native Youth Centre only.

Art Piece on Exterior Wall by Main Entrance



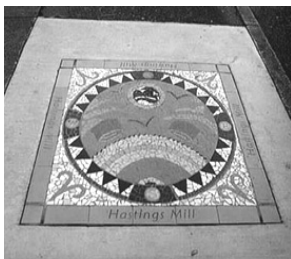
Eight donors of \$1,000,000 to \$1,999,999 will have their names included on a plaque below a 2 x 3 foot unique work of art to be commissioned by a Native youth artist in honor of the donor. Each art piece will be mounted on the exterior wall by the main entrance of the NYC (sample shown in picture). The plaque will indicate that the donor sponsored the artwork. Donors will receive a framed photo with the youth artist and be given agreed upon rights to use the artwork in their promotional materials in relation to the Native Youth Centre only.

Art Panels on Exterior of the NYC



Ten donors of \$200,000 to \$999,999 will have their name included on a plaque near the main entrance of the NYC. The plaque will indicate that the artwork was commissioned to honor the donor. The placements of names will from top to bottom according to the size of the donation (largest to smallest). The artwork will be shown on one of the 12 X 8 foot panels on the exterior of the second floor of the NYC (shown in picture). Donors will receive a framed photo with the youth artist and be given agreed upon rights to use the artwork in their promotional materials in relation to the NYC only.

Tile in Walkway Leading up to the NYC Entrance



Twenty donors of \$50,000 to \$199,999 will have their name included in a quote on a unique 2 x 2 foot tiles leading up to the main entrance of the NYC. Tiles will be placed in the most prominent spaces according to the size of the donation (largest to smallest). The tiles will include artwork commissioned by a Native youth, and have a unique statement written by the NYC Team such as “The ABC Book Company is proud to support Native youth literacy” (sample shown in picture). Donors will receive a framed photo with the youth artist and be given agreed upon rights to use the artwork in their promotional materials in relation to the Native Youth Centre only.
